PREAMBLE:

Forging partnerships and building relationships with fellow institutions, agencies, and NGOs will lead to an active role in society and a meaningful achievement in the present globalized world. It is, in fact, the need of the hour to work in collaboration to achieve and maintain quality standards in Teaching Learning valuation, Research, and Extension activities. This helps produce quality student service and may also complement skills and resources between the parties. The institutes and NGOs should join hands to improve the standards in the field. This collaboration will also help tackle and find solutions to the local problems and work together for the area's sustainable development.

In View of the increasingly adverse effects of global warming and other environmental hazards on human life on and off the campus. The College Management has decided to take appropriate measures to create awareness among the stakeholders on Water conservation, and other environmental factors affecting human life. As the College does not have the expertise, it has decided to rope in an NGO with having proven track record in the field for not only making the campus green and pollution-free but also conducting awareness programs for all the stakeholders. It is found that "Paramvishwa Foundation" a Nanded based Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) has been doing a great job in the fields like water conservation, rainwater harvesting, green campus promoting alternative energy sources, etc.

Now, therefore, both parties have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MOU), which defines the framework for the mutual cooperation set out in the following sections.

WHEREAS:

Government College of Education, Nanded is a teacher training institute in Nanded, Maharashtra. It was established in the year 1968. This institution is affiliated with Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathwada University, Nanded. The institute is recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC). The institute is well known for its commitment to education and has given many eminent students who have enriched their name in the education and research field. The sole crux of starting this college was providing teacher education to students from this underprivileged region of Maharashtra to enable them to compete globally.

The college is recognized by the UGC under sections 2(f) and 12(B). Looking at the future need for teacher training in our country the college is prominent in creating skillful human resources in the field of education who are competent to fulfill the challenges of society. This institute is a recognized research center of SRTMU Nanded. Various departments are working and different activities are conducted to create successful teachers and researchers.

In this teacher training institute, organized seminars, conferences, and workshops on life skills, communication skills, research attitude, and the use of ICT are inculcated in teacher-trainees and also for the in-service teacher so that perfect teachers are shaped in this institute.



WHEREAS:

Paramvishwa Foundation Nanded, established in 2017, is one of the Non- Government Organizations (NGO) based in Nanded, strives to create awareness among the people on water conservation, water management, environment conservation, and understanding the various schemes of the government to help the people at the grassroots level to achieve its objectives.

BROAD AREAS OF COLLABORATION:

Both parties agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the chosen area of mutual interest, based on equality and reciprocity.

1. Organizing Awareness programs for the students, staff, parents, and the general public of Puma
2. Taluka on " Water Management/ Conservation/Rainwater harvesting".
3. Maintaining Pollution free Campus (various measures).
4. Environmental conservations.
5. Conducting Green Audit
6. Energy Conservation/ Alternative Energy Resources (Solar energy).
7. Utilization of solar energy on the campus.
8. Disposal of e-waste.
9. Conducting Awareness for the Students and the Staff on careful use of water.
10. Management of solid waste by composting it in organic manure.

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity, setting forth detailed arrangements for collaboration will be agreed. Terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment or such exchange, including the financial liabilities will be decided mutually as and when the need arises between the parties. A separate agreement will be entered into giving such details including terms of exchange of any intellectual property. The Government College of Education Nanded and PVF do hereby agree that the detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two parties as and when needed. These terms shall include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements, and person(s) responsible for its implementation.

ARTICLE 1: COORDINATION

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the program on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee consisting of a program coordinator from the side of the Government College of Education Nanded and the President from the side of Paramvishwa Foundation, Nanded, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

ARTICLE 2: DISCLAIMER

This MoU is not intended by the Government College Of Education and PVF to constitute, create and give effect to any formal business organization of any kind. Each party



hereto shall act as an independent entity, and neither shall act as an agent of either organization for other purposes. Neither party has the authority to bind the other party.

ARTICLE 3: NON-EXCLUSIVITY

The agreement reflected by the provisions of this MoU is non-exclusive in nature and both parties can enter into cooperative arrangements with any other parties to suit their organizational needs.

ARTICLE 4: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

Government College of Education & Paramvishwa Foundation, Nanded will not absolve any confidential information during the research activity.

ARTICLE 5: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Ownership of any intellectual property (including but not limited to confidential information, know-how, patents, copyrights, design rights, rights relating to computer software, and any other industrial or intellectual property rights) developed jointly during the course of this MOU shall be vested in both the institutes to this Memorandum.

Both parties shall have the joint right to determine the commercial exploitation and disposition of such intellectual property, and both institutes shall make joint applications for the registration of the same. Before any registration or commercialization of any intellectual property takes place, the institutes agree to reach a separate agreement covering issues such as exploitation rights and revenue sharing. Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall only be possible with the prior written consent of both institutes, such consent not to be unreasonably withheld. Both parties shall be free to use perpetually the results arising out of the collaborating activities for their own internal teaching, research, educational, clinical, and publication purposes without the payment of royalties or other fees to the other party.

ARTICLE 6: VALIDITY

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of FIVE years commencing from the effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after a formal review.

ARTICLE 7: TERMINATION

Either institution may terminate the MOU by giving written notice Six months in advance to the other institution. Once terminated, neither Government College of Education Nanded nor Paramvishwa Foundation, Nanded will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, both institutes will ensure that the provisions of this Memorandum shall continue to apply to all activities in progress until their completion.

ARTICLE 8: AMENDMENTS/MODIFICATIONS

This MOU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both institutes.



ARTICLE 9: ADHERENCE TO LAWS

Participating faculties, staff, and *students* involved in any activity under this Memorandum must adhere to the rules and regulations of the participating institutions.

ARTICLE 10: LEGAL IMPLICATIONS

Nothing in this Memorandum shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the institutes. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

ARTICLE 11: DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In case, there is a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, the Government College of Education Nanded and The President, of Paramvishwa Foundation, Nanded will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility. In witness whereof each of the parties has caused this MoU to be executed in Two originals, one has to be retained by Government College of Education, Nanded, and the other by PVF on this day.
